

Stylios Koulouris is a Food Technologist by training with postgraduate studies in food biotechnology (MSc). In 2019, he was awarded the title of Honorary Doctor of food safety by the Sokhumi State University of Georgia.

He worked for more than ten years in the food industry (food ingredients) and six years in the Hellenic Food Authority (EFET) as inspector/auditor.
